Master's Message

On the Level

In my last message I spoke of being plumb. Closely related, even more than you may think, is the term level. "Are you on the level?" is an expression commonly used by the general populace. I'm not sure if we as Masons can take credit for that usage but there is no doubt that many of our Masonic precepts have been and are used by the general public. That said, let us examine our Masonic uses of the term level.

Of greatest importance is the fact that we meet on the level, wherein we mean that all of us stand as equal brothers. Material wealth, stature and position are not the true value of a man. Looking at the tools of the early operative masons, it will be noticed that the level they used was not the present day bubble balance level, but rather a small plumb line mounted at a square angle to the base, which demonstrates an interesting relationship between the plumb and level.

Take note of another Masonic symbol: the scale or the balance. This device indicates when two quantities are equal in weight by the arm being level and which is indicated by a pointer that is perpendicular or square to the arm. The symbol of the scale is often seen in the hand of the Greek goddess Themis, and is used to represent justice or honesty.

So from these symbols, what have we to learn? Only that we must always be honest and just with each other as equals. Remember, "every human being has a claim on our kind offices". Let us show others by our example that Masons live by their understanding of these symbolisms in their daily life. May we therefore recognize that at the end of life's journey over the level of time we will come to realize the absolute equality of each of us in the eyes of God.

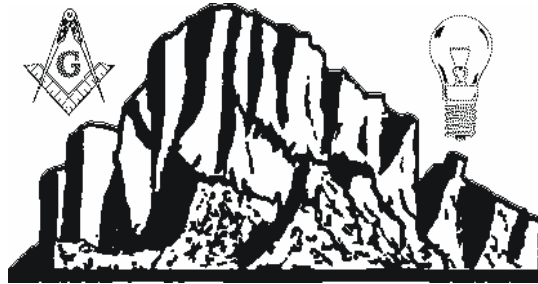
